Subject: **Energy Efficiency Requirements**

New energy efficiency requirements

New energy efficiency regulations for ships are expected to enter into force on 1 January 2013. Ships of 400 GT and above will be required to carry an International Energy Efficiency Certificate, certifying that a ship specific Ship Energy Efficiency Management Plan (SEEMP) is on board. New ships will also have to comply with an Energy Efficiency Design Index (EEDI), although this will not apply to offshore support vessels for the time being. The accompanying guidance, including guidelines on the development of a SEEMP, has been finalized and will be circulated to members.

Companies should start preparing their ship specific plans.
