Survey Plan for Special Survey for non-tankers/bulkers

1. General.

- Where and when will the Special Survey be held
- Where and when will the Drydocking Survey be held
- Where and when will the Thickness Measurements be carried out.
- Name and address of the Thickness Measurements firm
- Has the ship documentation, including survey reports and previous repair history, been reviewed to determine damage experience related to the vessel

2. Permanent Ballast Tanks: List and ballast tanks that have permanent ballast.

3. Hatch Covers and Coamings: A thorough examination, which include close-up survey of hatch cover plating and hatch coamings plating to be carried out.

4. Tanks/Hold Particulars: General arrangement showing tank/hold arrangement may be attached. Method of corrosion protection and condition of any coating in the tank may be detailed,

Notation: C=hard coating, SC=soft coating, A=anodes, NP=no protection

GOOD=condition with only minor spot rusting

FAIR=condition with local breakdown at edges of stiffeners and weld connection and/or light rusting over 20% or more of areas under consideration, but less than as defined for POOR condition.

POOR=condition with general breakdown of coating over 20% or more of areas or hard scale at 10% or more of areas under consideration.

5. Internal Examination of Fuel Oil, Lube Oil and Fresh Water Tanks: Where tanks of integral structure type, except for peak tanks, are used primary for fuel oil or fresh water internal examination is to be carried out.
6. Thickness Measurements: The minimum requirements applicable for the type of the ship: proposed locations and extend.
7. Thanks testing: Proposed schedule for Tank Testing.
